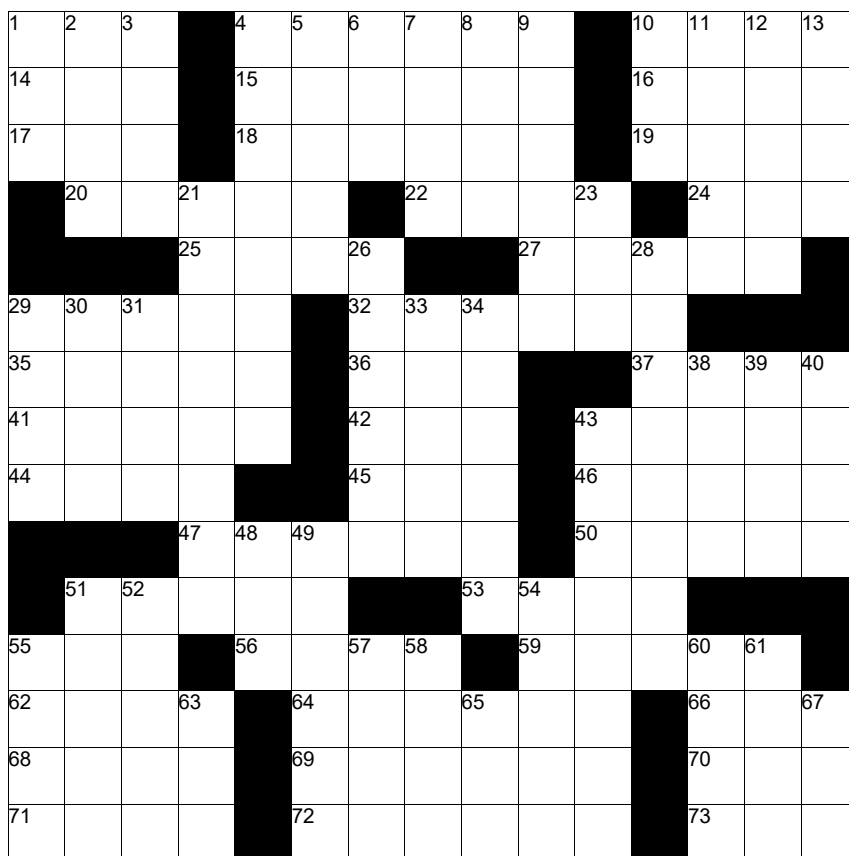


"Triple Deckers" a metapuzzle by Peter Washington
